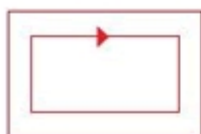

Call for Papers

The IFAC World Congress is the forum of excellence for the exploration of the frontiers in Control science and technology, attended by a worldwide audience of scientists and engineers from academy and industry. It offers the most up to date and complete view of control techniques, with the widest coverage of application fields. In 2014, the congress will be held in Cape Town, South Africa and the theme of the congress will be "Promoting automatic control for the benefit of humankind".

Original submissions covering the broad spectrum of topics in Automation and Control spanned by IFAC are invited. Papers should be of high quality in accordance with the tradition of previous IFAC World Congresses. For further instructions, please download the full Call for Papers [here](#).

Pre-Congress Workshops and Tutorials

Proposals for the pre-congress workshops and tutorials are also invited. These will inform participants about the state of the art in specific areas of interest to the IFAC community.

Extended Abstracts

The congress will accept a limited number of papers based on extended abstracts, to encourage participation from industry and from colleagues outside the traditional academic control community. Typically, these abstracts will be two pages in length and will be subject to peer review. Authors will present in technical or interactive sessions but the papers will not appear in the congress proceedings.
